The "living-well" of each and everyone

...common because is

NOT a having an ownership, an individual possession





BUT the good of the whole COMMUNITY



- Cum-munus with/through a gift
- "The munus that the communitas shares is not a property or a belonging. It is not a having, but, on the contrary, a debt, a pledge, a gift-to-give." (Ref. Esposito R. «Communitas – Origine e destino della comunità», Einaudi 2006)
- The meaning of community is in the reciprocity of the gift, it is the obligation to reciprocate that creates bonding (Ref. Marcel Mauss)
- The concept of community does not reward individualism but enhances subjectivities by widening the gaze towards the common good → reciprocity or mutuality of giving that delivers each other into a common commitment
